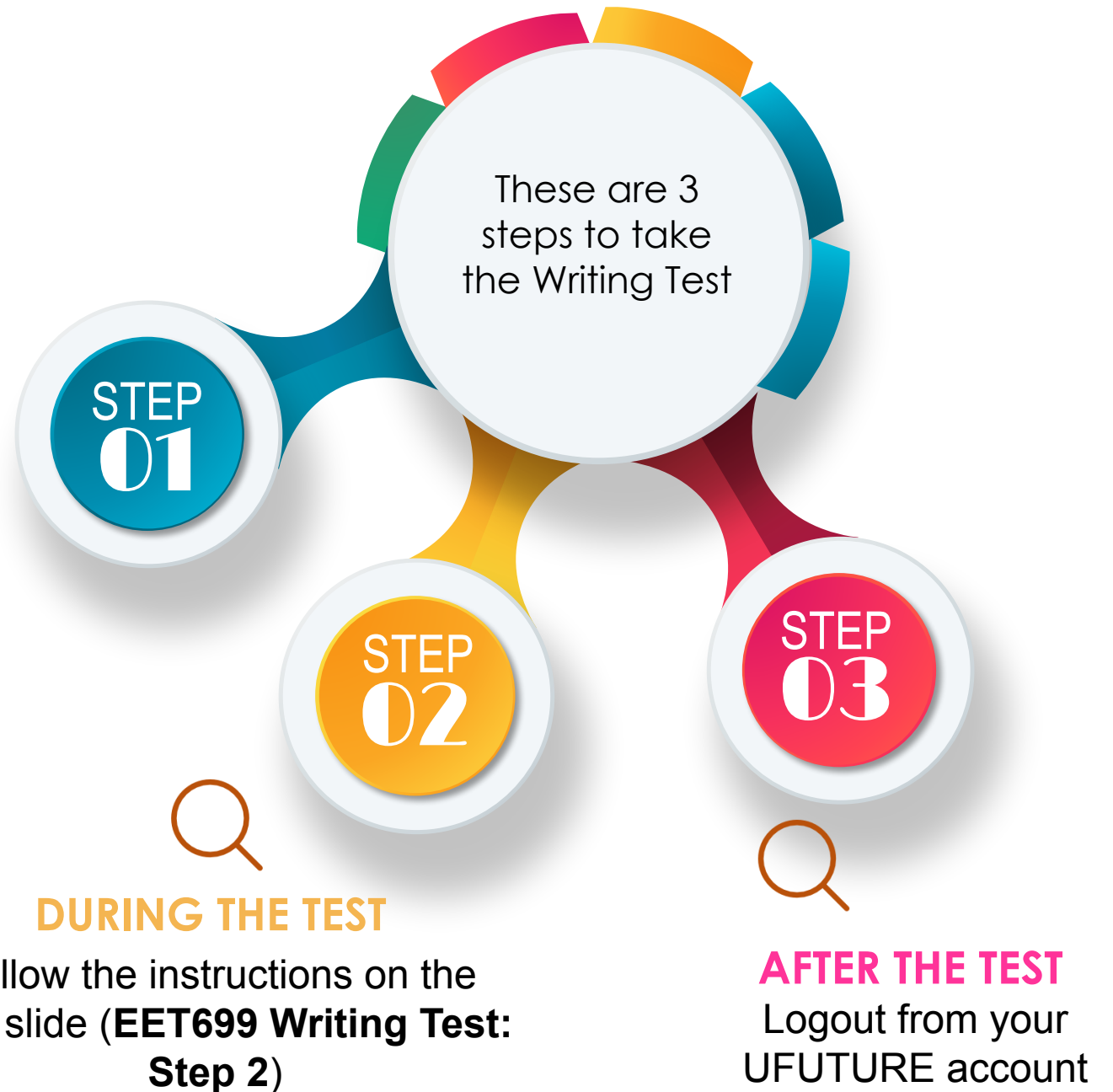
EET699 Writing Test

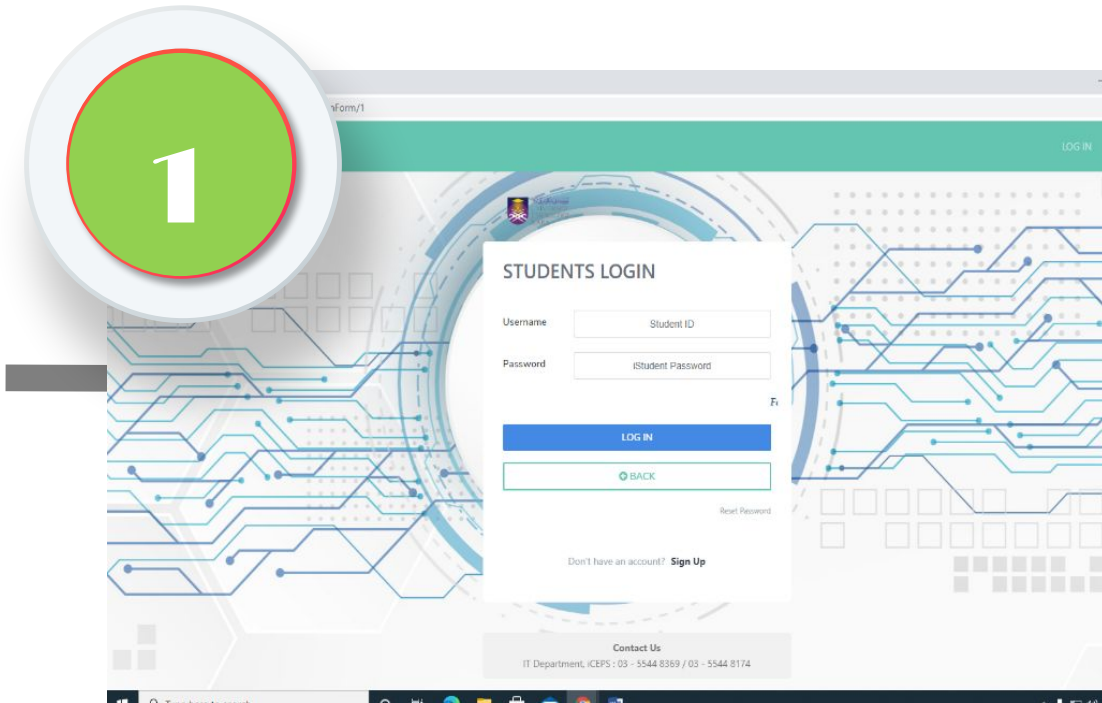

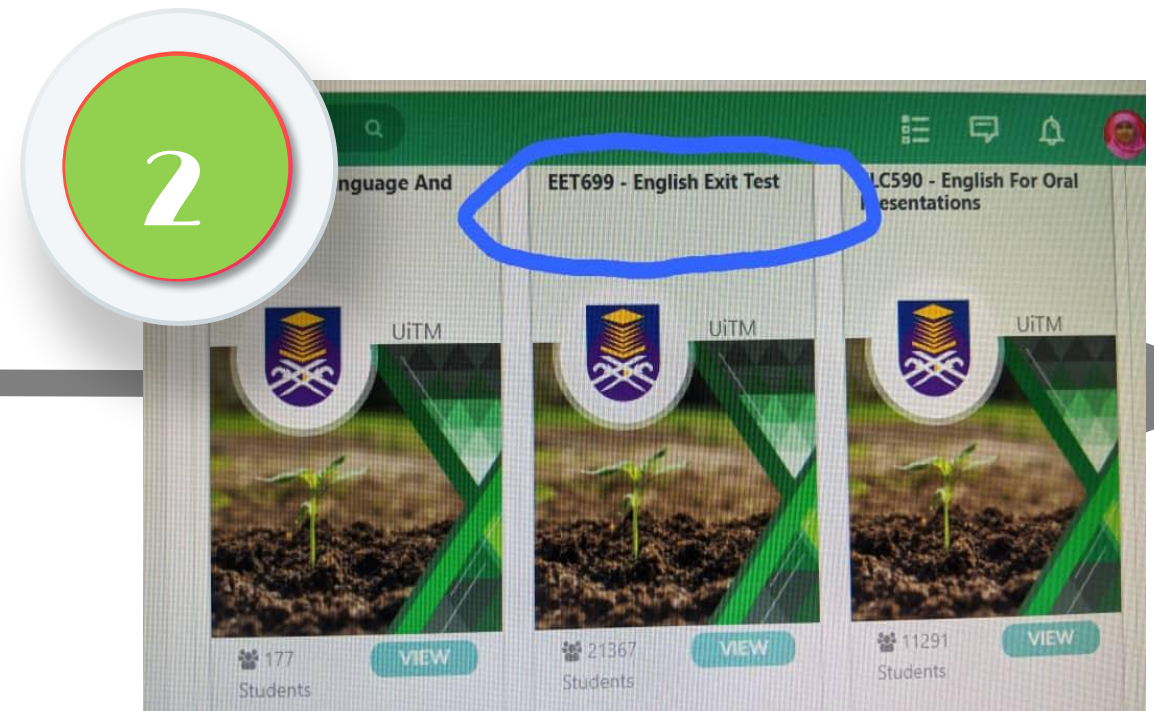

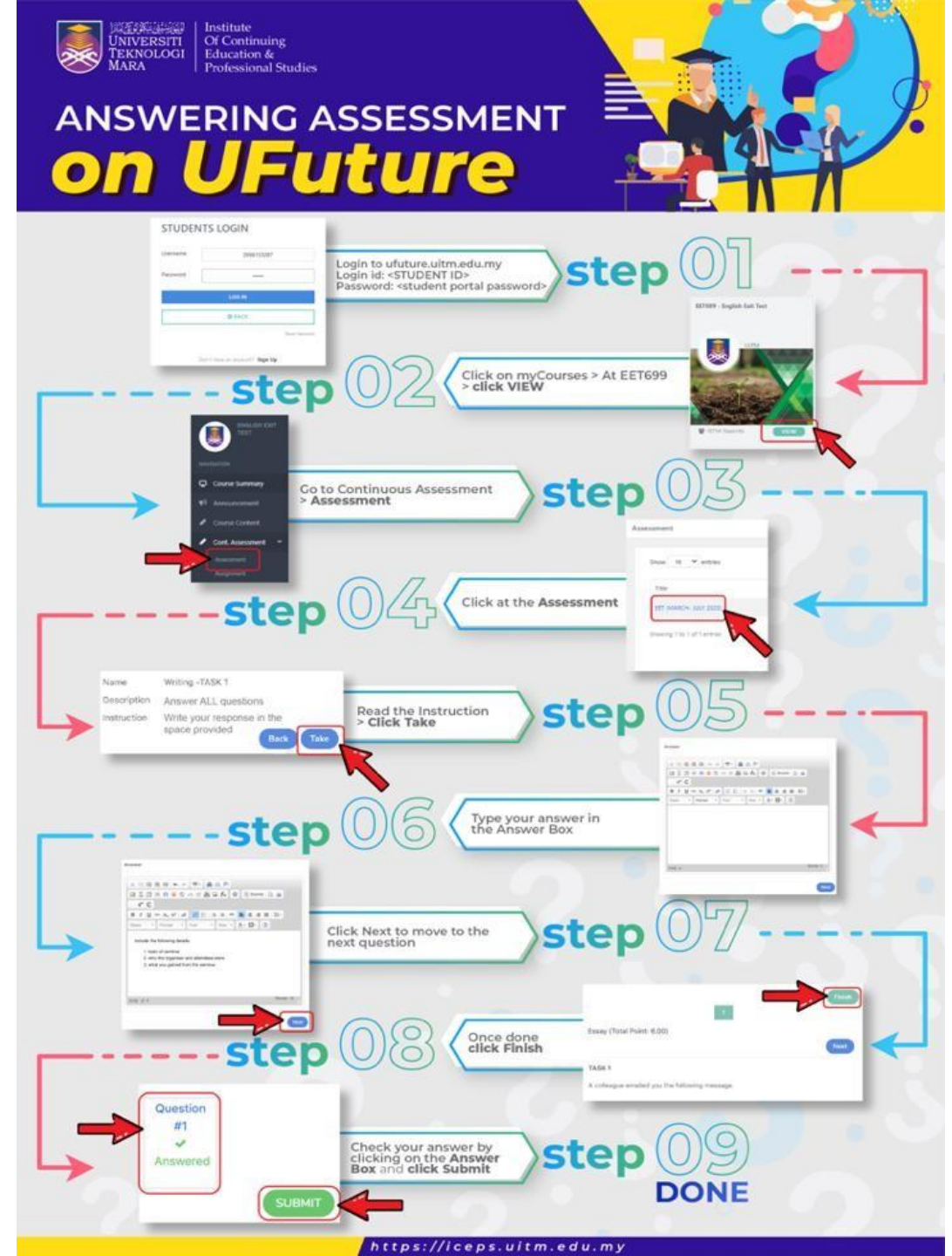


Go to EET699 – English Exit Test, click on VIEW

Plagiarism is a serious offence. Students who plagiarise in the EET Writing Test will be punished.

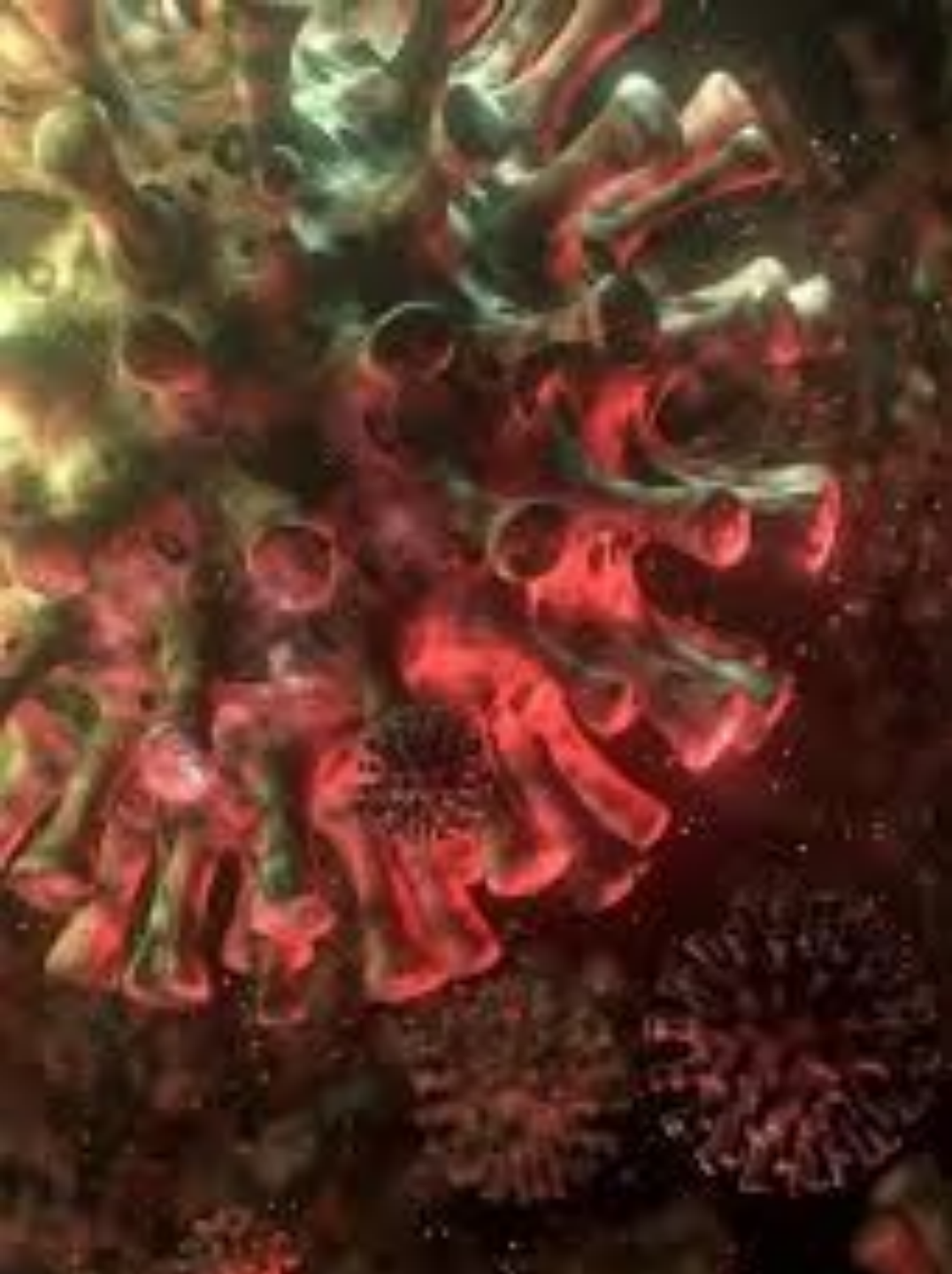


PLAGIARISM
